Better Health for More Children and Hope for a Better Future



Mario's life was transformed because of the help he received at the Nutrition Center! Malnutrition is one of the main problems in developing countries, affecting mostly children under five, compromising their immune system and leading them to infectious diseases or death in many cases. Also many malnourished children grow up with physical or mental disabilities that forever limit their potential. The Nutrition Center in Honduras uses a very inexpensive low-cost program where children and families can recover in 1 to 3 months with good medical care, good hygiene, nutritious food, and safe water.



Mario, pictured left, is one of many examples of children who recovered from malnutrition. He came to the Nutritional Rehabilitation Center in July of 2017. He was 12 years old and had severe malnutrition. The Honduras staff immediately started to provide care to Mario and his family. At the beginning Mario didn't have energy but after a few weeks he began to recover. A couple of months later, Mario and his family returned to their home.

Recently the Honduran staff visited the family to see how they were doing and if they needed more help. Mario is now 17 years old and he works in a sugar plantation. *He and his mother are forever grateful with HNH.*

Mario's recovery motives us to keep helping as many families as we can. We know that Mario will have a better life and brighter future.

Deworming Program

Intestinal parasites consume up to a quarter of a child's food that they intake. For a child who already eats very little, this can be devastating to their nutrition and growth. Healthy Niños has always participated in deworming medicine distributions, helping to rid people of their intestinal parasites. In addition, Healthy Niños has been able to network with other organizations to provide deworming pills for them to disribute as well.

We are very grateful for a recent donation of 500,000 tablets of Albendazole deworming medicines from The Worm Project.

This will help many people throughout the rural areas of Honduras!





A Dream Coming True: Update on the Warehouse Construction

For years we dreamed about having **space to receive and store donations easily.** We have been offered donations for food from area organizations and businesses but have had no way to store and distribute it easily. Being able to finally see this project to completion, has been wonderful.

As the construction continues and the second floor is being closed out, we start planning on our first donations that will leave from the warehouse. We see our ability to *help even more families with gifts of food, clothes, and other supplies.*

HNH gives thanks to all of you for your generous support. Our goal is to raise \$60,000 to finish all of the details including the water harvestation project that will be completed next.

Mobile Nutrition Center

With our facilities closed due to the ongoing pandimic, we implemented a Mobile Nutrition Center. The staff is visiting families who had been in the Center in the past or were going to come to the Center due to their children's nutrition state.

In the last few months we have been able to visit 11 communities. Out of the 162 children evaluated, sadly, 123 had some level of malnutrition. We are able to provide medical care, food, toys, shoes, and clothes. In addition, the staff provides short educational talks about healthy hygiene and eating habits.

We will not give up in providing the help to the children and families in need. Your support allows us to continue this work!











Providing Concrete Floors in Homes

It may seem so simple but it is an important part of creating a healthy living environment. Concrete floors can be kept clean and are more sanitary for sleeping as well.
